In June of 2022, [REDACTED] Recording Secretary of Branch 142 Filed the following against K. Hooks. in accordance with my right to prefer Article 10 charges against K. Hooks Branch 142: I specifically charge Hooks with neglect of the duties of his office, failure to discharge the duties of his office and misconduct of his failure of his duty of fair representation. September 2, 2022, I e-mailed KHooks asking him to provide me with the date a grievance was filed on my NOR. K. Hooks responded with: Notice of Removal Dated: 03/24/2021 Filing Date 08/04/2021. This is why I lost my job, he took too long to file.
